Zoeller Company supports this policy through its actions, such as announced and unannounced inspections of production facilities. Zoeller Company reserves the right to conduct audits, which shall include but is not limited to audits of all supplier facilities, processes, components, materials and finished goods. Employees have a responsibility to report any violations of the Code of Conduct. Suppliers who do not comply with our Code of Conduct may be terminated. This disclosure is intended to comply with the California Transparency in Supply Chains Act and is applicable to all covered Zoeller Company affiliate companies.
